- 5) **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – COURSES AND PROGRAMME.** Sailing Instructions for all events will be as per the 2026 Sailing Instructions contained on the <https://www.cpyawa.com/>
- 6) **SPEEDS:** Nominated speeds must be from 5 to 15 knots or as adjusted by Clause 22 of the Rules.
- 7) **COMPLIANCE:** Every competing power yacht shall comply with the minimum marina requirements of their club of origin.
- 8) **SCORING SYSTEM FOR CHAMPIONSHIP:** In accordance with Rules, refer Appendix 2, Clause 3.
- 9) **SCORING SYSTEM FOR TEAMS EVENTS:** In accordance with the Rules, refer Appendix 2, Clause 2 with all events completed to count.
- 10) **REDRESS and PROTESTS:** All redress and protest requests shall be lodged and heard in accordance with the Rules. Contestants are requested to consult the Rules and follow the requirements and timing for written submissions.
- 11) **PRESENTATIONS:** Presentations post event will be publicised by each of the OA's in the lead up to each of the events. RPYC is the nominated club for the 2026 season presentations and further advice will be provided as the season progresses.
